

When a nor'easter floods a community in New Bedford, or a mill fire in Lawrence knocks senseless water service for blocks, toilets come to be more than a comfort. ## **Bringing it together**

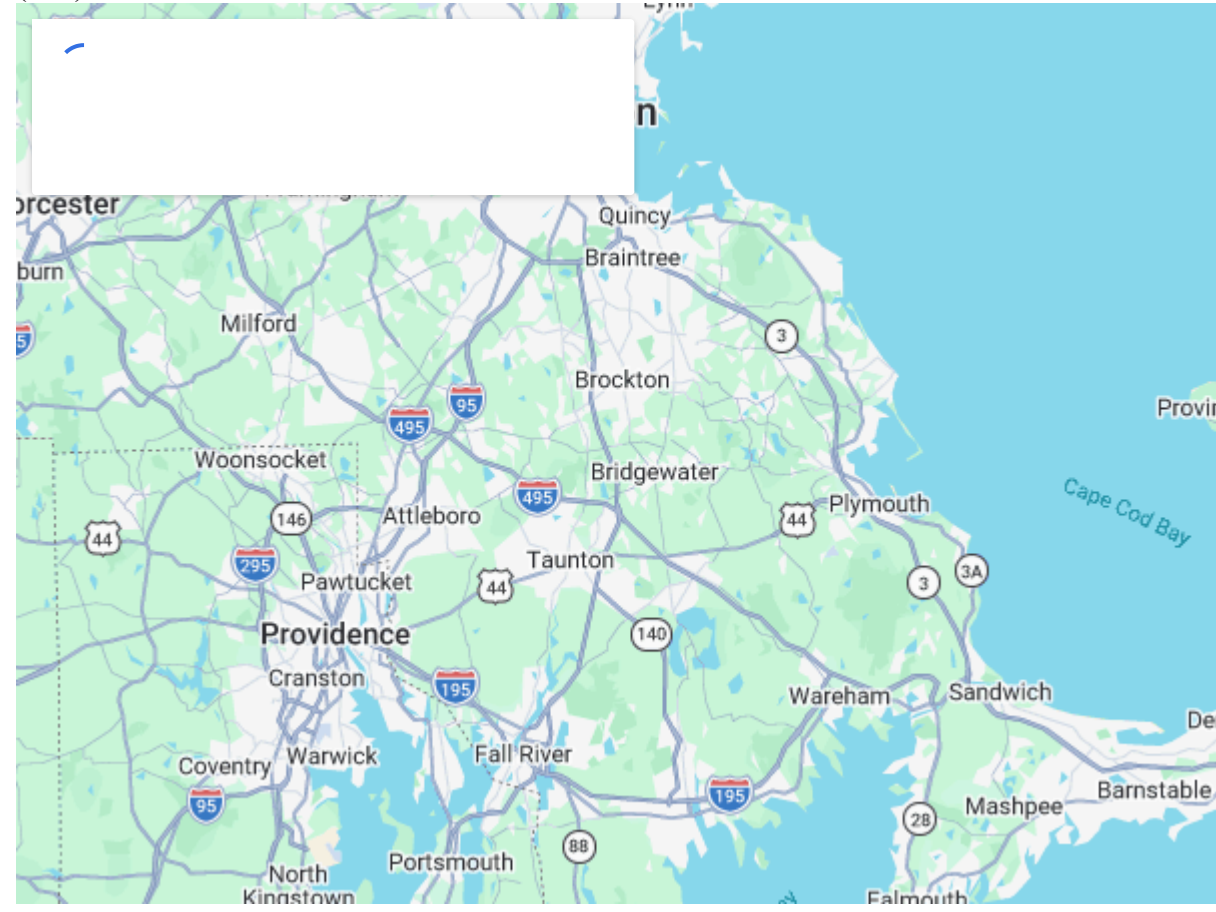
