What Is Delta Airlines Flight Change?

A Delta flight change allows an eligible passenger to modify certain details of an existing reservation. Depending on the ticket and itinerary, travelers may be able to change:

- **Travel date**
- **Departure time**
- **Flight itinerary**
- **Eligible routing**
- **Certain booking details**

The availability of these options depends on the fare type, route, ticket conditions, and other applicable rules. Before making a change, passengers should review their reservation and the conditions associated with their ticket.



Check Your Ticket Eligibility

The first step in the **Delta Airlines Change Flight** process is checking whether your ticket qualifies for a change.

Passengers should review:

Ticket type

Origin and destination

Travel date

Fare conditions

Remaining value of the
ticket

Any applicable
restrictions

Whether the ticket was purchased directly from Delta or through
another travel provider

Some tickets may have different change conditions, so travelers should check the specific reservation before selecting a new flight.

How to Change a Delta Flight Online?

One of the simplest ways to modify an eligible reservation is through Delta's website or app.

General steps:

Open your Delta reservation.

Select the option to manage
or modify the trip.

Choose the flight-change
option.

Review available
replacement flights.

Select a new date or time.

Confirm the new itinerary.

Enter or confirm your booking
information if requested.

Review the fare difference
and applicable charges.

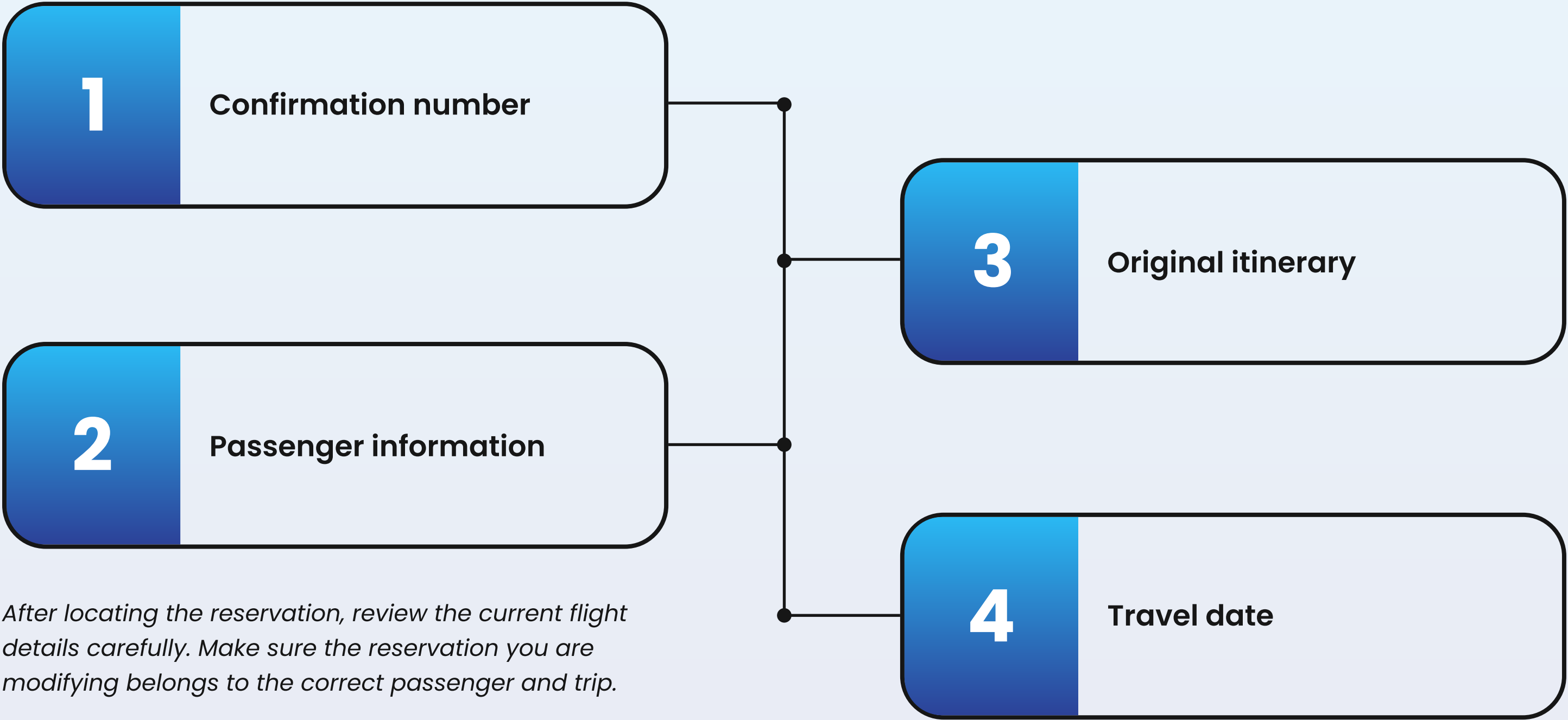
Save the updated
confirmation details.

The exact options displayed can vary depending on the reservation.

Find Your Reservation

To begin the change process, travelers generally need access to their existing reservation.

Keep your confirmation information available, such as:

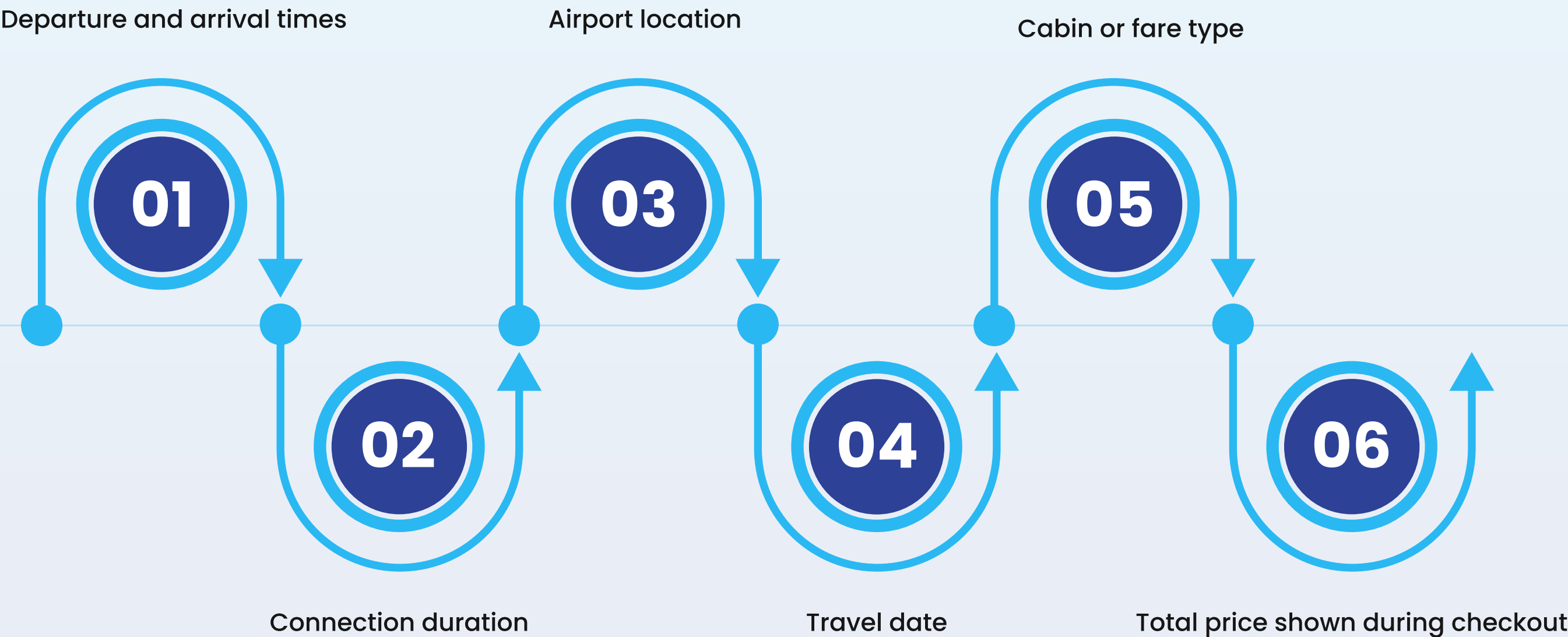


After locating the reservation, review the current flight details carefully. Make sure the reservation you are modifying belongs to the correct passenger and trip.

Select a New Flight

After entering the change process, eligible replacement flights may be displayed. Travelers can compare available dates and departure times before selecting a new itinerary.

When choosing a replacement flight, consider:



A different flight may have a higher or lower fare than the original booking. The final amount should be reviewed before completing the change.

Understanding Change Fees and Fare Differences

One important part of the **delta airlines change flight** process is understanding the difference between a change fee and a fare difference.

Depending on the ticket and itinerary, Delta may allow certain changes without a separate change fee, while a fare difference can still apply when the replacement flight costs more.

For example, if the original ticket has a value of \$300 and the new eligible flight costs \$350, the reservation may require payment of the applicable \$50 fare difference. Exact conditions vary, so passengers should rely on the amount displayed for their specific reservation.

What Happens If the New Flight Costs Less?

If the replacement flight is priced lower than the original itinerary, the treatment of the remaining value depends on the ticket's terms and applicable Delta rules.

Travelers should carefully review the summary presented before confirming the change. Any remaining value, credit, or other applicable treatment should be clearly understood before completing the transaction.

It is important not to assume that every ticket receives the same treatment.



Changing a Flight Through the Delta App

Travelers who use the Delta mobile app may also be able to manage eligible reservations from their smartphone.

A typical process involves:

Opening the Delta app.

Accessing the trip or reservation.

Choosing another flight.

Reviewing the updated itinerary.

Checking any price difference.

Confirming the change.

Selecting the available modification option.

Using the app can be convenient when travelers need to review their itinerary while away from a computer.
