What Is Delta WiFi?

Delta WiFi is the airline's in-flight internet service available on many Delta flights. Depending on the aircraft, route, and service availability, passengers may be able to access complimentary WiFi for browsing and other online activities.

Before your flight, it is a good idea to make sure your phone, tablet, or laptop is ready to connect. Keep your device charged and enable WiFi once you are permitted to use electronic devices during the flight.

How to Connect to Deltawifi

Keep background apps closed: Automatic updates and cloud synchronization can consume bandwidth. Close unnecessary applications to make your connection more efficient.

Use lightweight websites: Text-based websites and email generally require less data than video-heavy pages.

Be patient during busy periods: Many passengers may connect at the same time, which can affect performance. If the connection feels slow, wait a few moments and try again.

What If Deltawifi Is Not Working?

If you cannot connect to Deltawifi, first check that your device's WiFi is turned on and that you have selected the correct onboard network. You can also disconnect and reconnect to the network, then reopen your browser.

If the connection page fails to appear, close the browser completely and try again. Turning WiFi off and back on may also resolve temporary connection problems.

Keep in mind that WiFi availability can depend on the aircraft and route. There may also be times when service is temporarily unavailable because of operational or technical factors.

Can You Use Deltawifi for Streaming?

The capabilities of onboard WiFi can vary by flight and service level. Basic activities such as messaging, browsing, and checking email are generally more practical than data-intensive activities. If you plan to work during your flight, download essential files before departure so you are not completely dependent on the internet connection.

Travelers searching online may come across terms such as deltawifi.com when looking for information about Delta's onboard WiFi. Be careful when entering website addresses and verify that you are using an official Delta resource or the onboard connection portal provided during your flight. Avoid entering personal or payment information on unfamiliar websites.
