Travel plans can change unexpectedly because of work, family commitments, weather, or other situations. Fortunately, Delta Air Lines provides several options for passengers who need to modify their itinerary. Understanding the [Delta Flight Change](#) policy can help you know what fees may apply, how to change your ticket, and what happens when the new flight costs more or less than the original.

What Is the Delta Flight Change Policy?

Delta allows eligible passengers to change their travel dates, times, or destinations before departure. For many tickets originating in the United States and Canada, Delta has eliminated change fees on Classic and Extra experiences. However, fare differences may still apply if the replacement flight costs more.

Basic tickets generally have more restrictions and may be subject to change or cancellation fees. Rules can also vary depending on where your journey originates, your ticket type, and your destination.

How to Change a Delta Flight

If you need to [Change flight delta](#), you can usually manage your reservation online through Delta's My Trips section or the Fly Delta app.

Follow these steps:

1. Visit Delta's website or open the Fly Delta app.
2. Select My Trips.
3. Enter or select your reservation.
4. Choose Change or Add Flights.
5. Search the available replacement flights.
6. Select your preferred itinerary.
7. Review any applicable fees or fare differences.
8. Confirm the change and receive your updated itinerary.

Delta states that passengers should make changes before departure to retain any eligible remaining ticket value.

Does Delta Charge a Flight Change Fee?

Change fees depend on your ticket type and travel origin. For many Classic and Extra tickets originating in the U.S. and Canada, Delta does not charge a change fee. However, Basic tickets may have a change fee, while some international itineraries can also have different restrictions.

Even when no change fee applies, you may have to pay a fare difference. For example, if your original ticket cost \$250 and the new flight costs \$350, you may need to pay the additional \$100.

If the new flight costs less, an eligible eCredit may be issued for the remaining value, depending on the ticket's terms.

Delta Basic Ticket Changes

Delta Basic experiences have stricter conditions than many other fare types. After the applicable risk-free cancellation period, Basic tickets may be changed or canceled for a fee, with the remaining eligible value generally issued as an eCredit.

The exact fee can depend on the itinerary and ticket conditions, so travelers should review the specific reservation before making changes.

Delta 24-Hour Risk-Free Cancellation

If you purchased a qualifying ticket directly from Delta for travel originating in the United States, Delta's 24-hour risk-free cancellation policy may allow you to cancel or change the ticket within one day of purchase without a cancellation or change fee. A full refund may be available under the applicable conditions.

This option can be helpful if you discover an error in your booking shortly after purchase.

Same-Day Flight Changes

Delta also offers same-day travel options on eligible itineraries. Same-Day Confirmed may allow an eligible passenger to move to another flight on the same day, subject to availability and applicable rules.

Delta currently lists a \$75 fee for eligible Classic tickets, while the service can be complimentary for certain Extra, refundable, and qualifying Medallion-member tickets. Basic experiences are not eligible for Same-Day Confirmed.

Same-Day Standby may also be available for eligible travelers and can allow passengers to request an earlier flight without losing their original seat until the standby seat clears.

What Happens If You Miss the Change Deadline?

Passengers should change or cancel their itinerary before the scheduled departure. Delta states that tickets not changed or canceled before departure generally have no remaining value, subject to applicable exceptions and laws.

For this reason, travelers should avoid waiting until after departure if they know their plans have changed.

Tips for Changing Your Delta Flight

Before you Change flight delta, compare several replacement flights. A different departure time or date may have a lower fare difference.

Also check your ticket type, review the final price, and confirm the new travel dates carefully. If your plans are uncertain, understanding the flexibility of your fare before making changes can help prevent unnecessary costs.

Final Thoughts

The Delta Flight Change policy gives travelers several ways to modify their itinerary, but the rules depend on ticket type, travel origin, destination, and other factors. Many eligible Classic

and Extra tickets originating in the U.S. and Canada can be changed without a change fee, although fare differences may apply.
