Add an attendant for 45 to 65 dollars per hour with a 6-hour minimum consisting of prep, breaks, and post-service cleaning. Distribution within 25 miles may be consisted of, though many suppliers now charge 150 to 400 bucks for haulage because of fuel and labor costs. Power can come from the house if readily available, however if voltage is uncertain or distance surpasses 100 feet, a tiny quiet generator in the 5 to 7 kW course runs 150 to 300 bucks daily plus gas.
