How chilly is simply too cold to energy wash a condominium? Once air temperatures flirt with freezing, hoses, pumps, and rinse water behave badly. 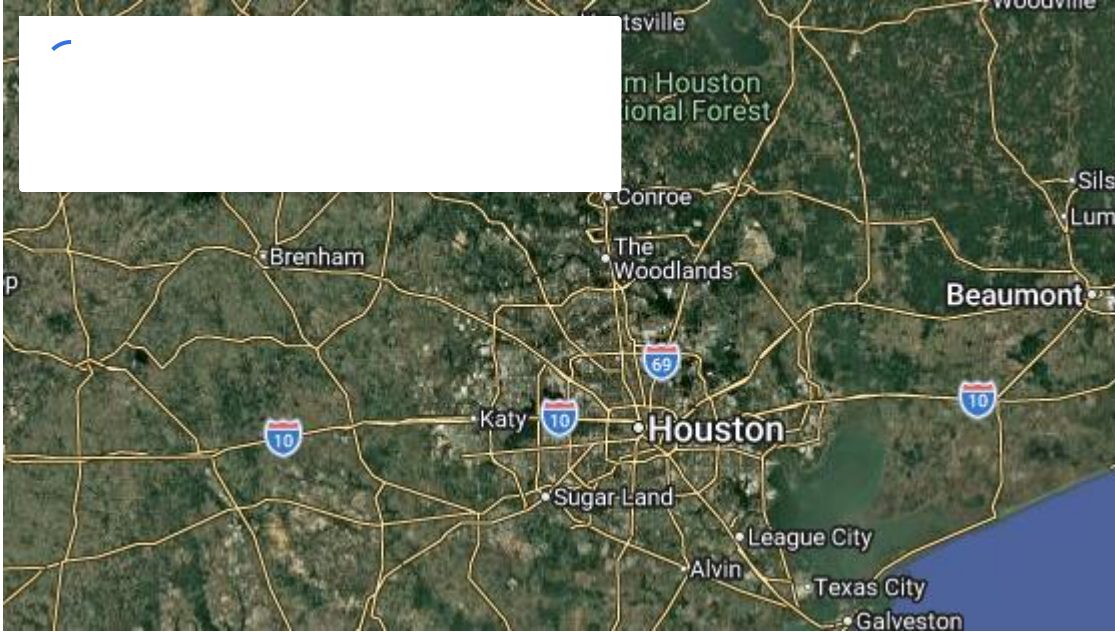
Bringing all of it together on a proper driveway
