Avoid ammonia close tinted or low-e lined interiors. On the coast or riverside the place salt spray creeps in, rinse longer with natural water to carry away crystal-forming minerals that entice extra grime later. If you've gotten bronze or black aluminum frames, prevent prime-alkaline cleaners off the paint. They can chalk the finish and depart permanent marks along your drip area.

## **A specialist workflow that works**

Walk a condo in PNW weather and your plan concerns as lots as your muscle. We bounce at the leeward side if a breeze is up, work shaded panes before the sun swings round, and leave sliders and French doorways for ultimate due to the fact pets and teens love to claim howdy after we have made them appropriate. On multi-pane colonial grids, we pre-wipe the muntins so resolution does no longer assemble and drip strains after the squeegee skip. On picture home windows, we smash the glass into sections with angled squeegee pulls so the solution does no longer outrun the rubber.

The most regularly occurring mistake we see is too little answer and too much scrubbing. On pollen-heavy days, dry scrubbing works like sandpaper. Better to rainy, reside for 30 to 60 seconds, then agitate flippantly and do away with. The live time does the heavy lifting, the squeegee finishes.

## **A quick, strong DIY task between professional visits**

Use this when you do no longer want full-carrier window washing, but haze and spots are commencing to stupid your view.

- Mix a bucket with hot water and a teaspoon of a mild, green window cleansing soap. No greater than that, or you will chase suds.
- Rinse the glass with a backyard sprayer or hose if pollen is heavy, then observe your solution with a mushy applicator or microfiber pad. Let it sit for 30 seconds.
- Squeegee ideal to bottom with secure stress, overlapping every one circulate with the aid of an inch. Wipe the rubber area with a dry fabric each and every stroke or two.

- Detail the sides with a blank microfiber nook. Do no longer use paper towels, which shed lint and promote streaks.
- Inspect from an attitude. If you see drag lines or rainbow smear, spot-treat with a gently alcohol-dampened microfiber and re-squeegee that part.

That 5-step rhythm matches what we use inside the area on regular panes. 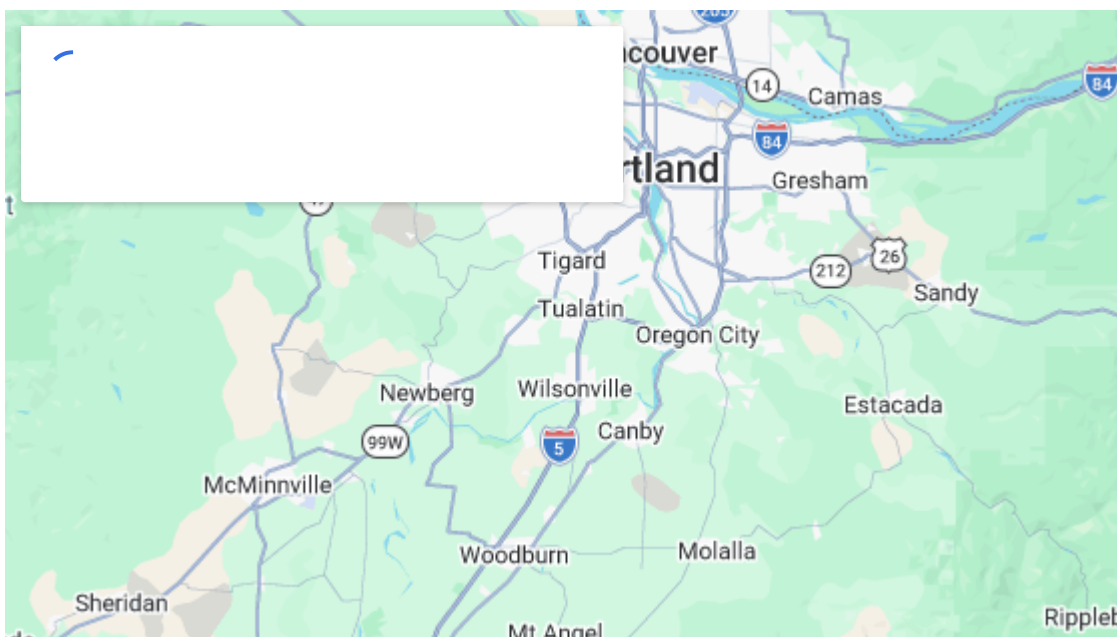
