How to think through an urgent call

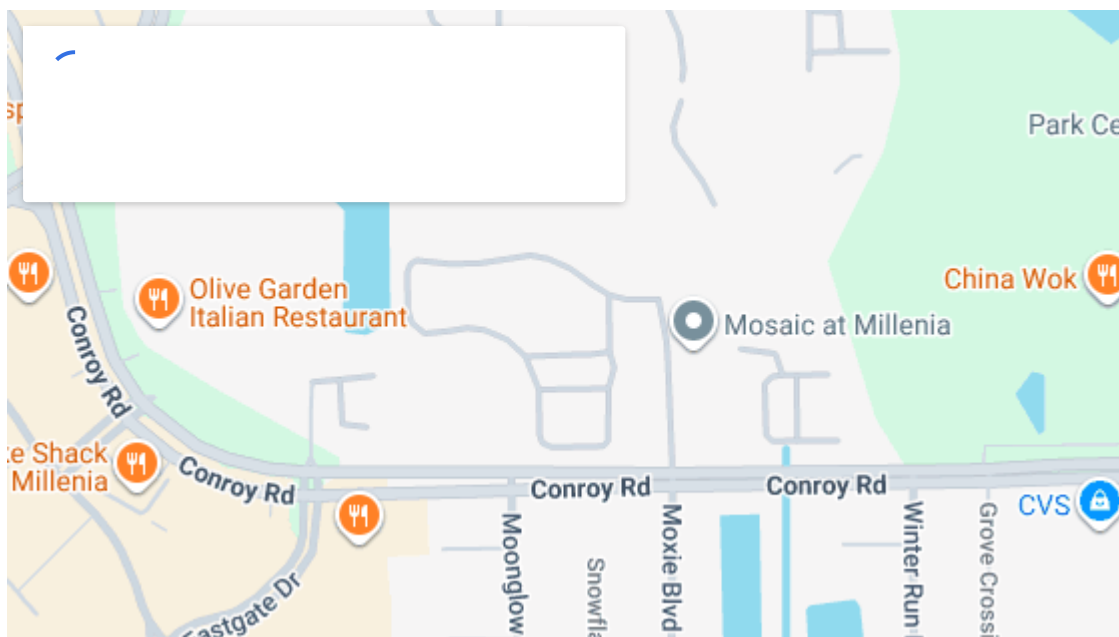
