Aim for sufficient capability that stops lines from creating longer than a min or more. Lines kill flow. They additionally nudge visitors to stray in search of a personal corner, which is exactly how you wind up with dissatisfied landowners and bad photos.

Where to place them so they really feel very discreet and easy
