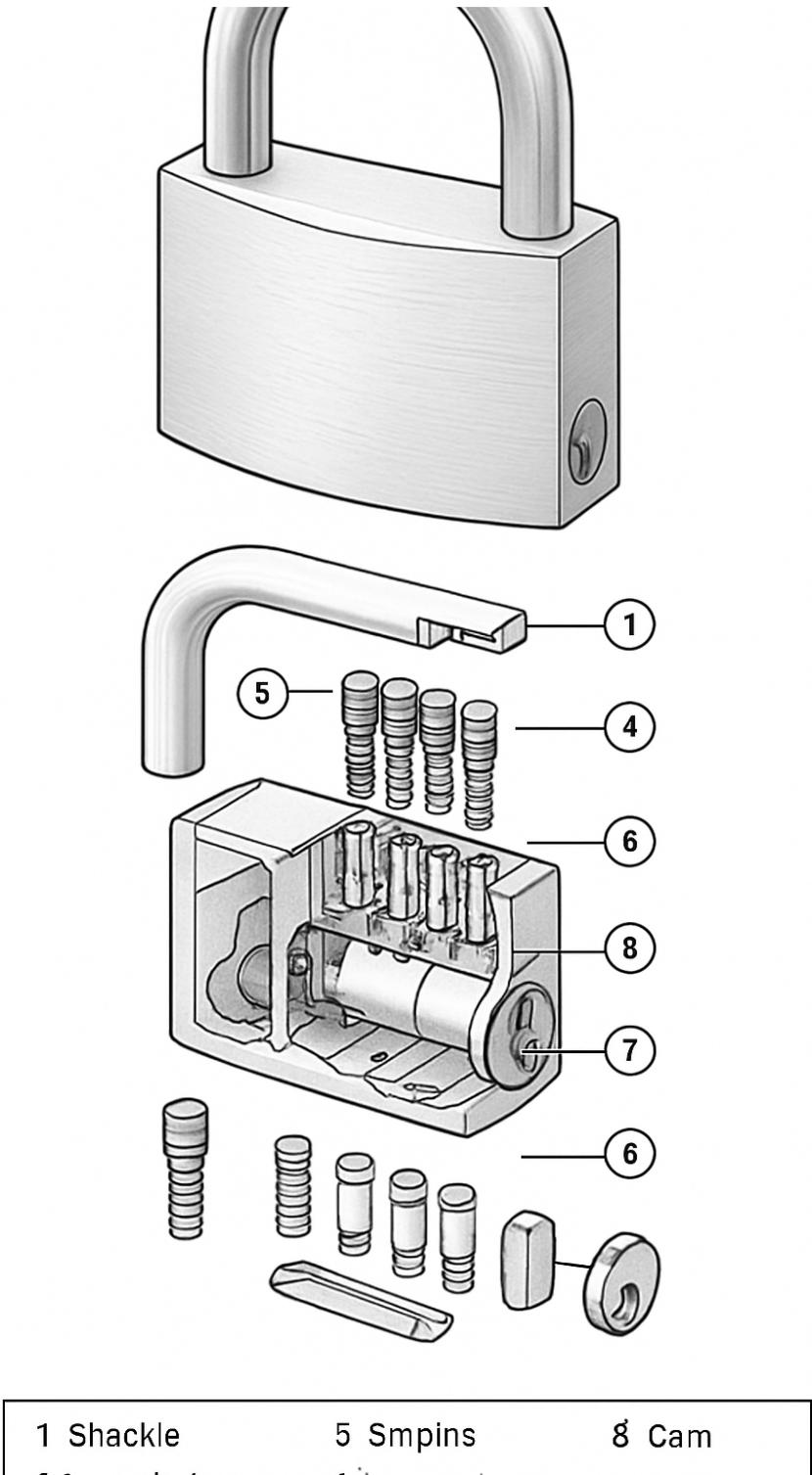

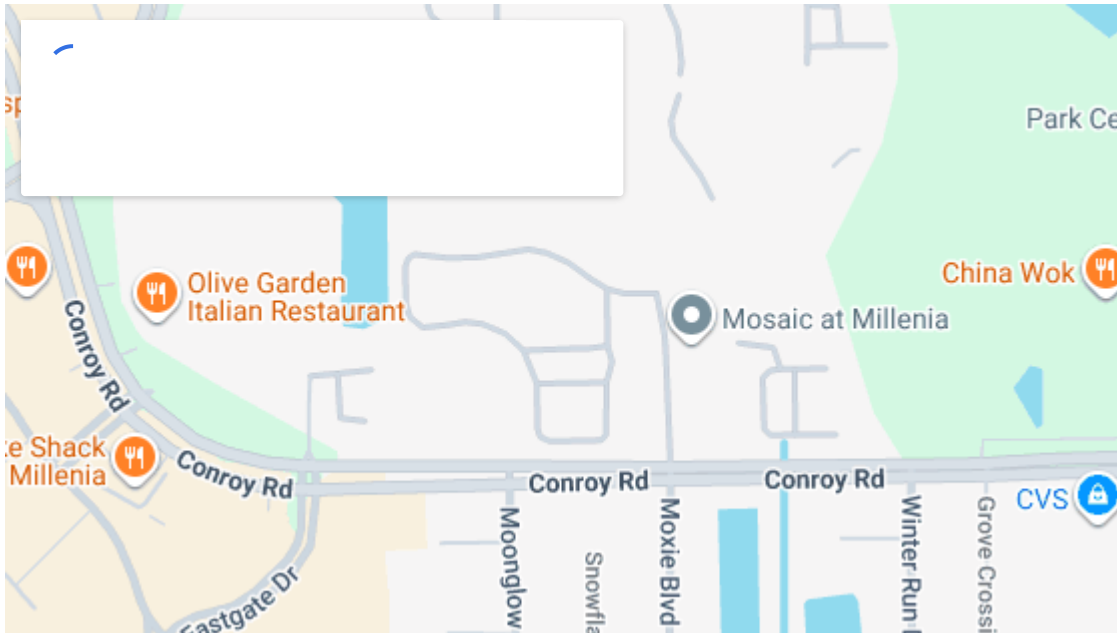
Which details make the visit smoother
