Are lighters permitted on airplanes?

However, torch lighters, jet flame lighters, and lighter refills are strictly prohibited in both carry-on and checked baggage due to safety risks.

Can I take a lighter on an airplane?

Disposable lighters on airplanes rules

Disposable lighters on airplanes are the most commonly allowed type, but even they must be carried responsibly. They should be kept with you, not packed in checked baggage, and must pass security screening.
