Track Record and Niche Expertise

How many weddings has this planner actually coordinated. Vague responses are red flags. Request specific numbers. Conversation Flow and Reply Speed

Send a test email before signing anything. How long do they take to respond? Are they patient or pushy? In your conversations, do they listen more than they talk? This matters enormously.

Pricing Openness and Cost Control

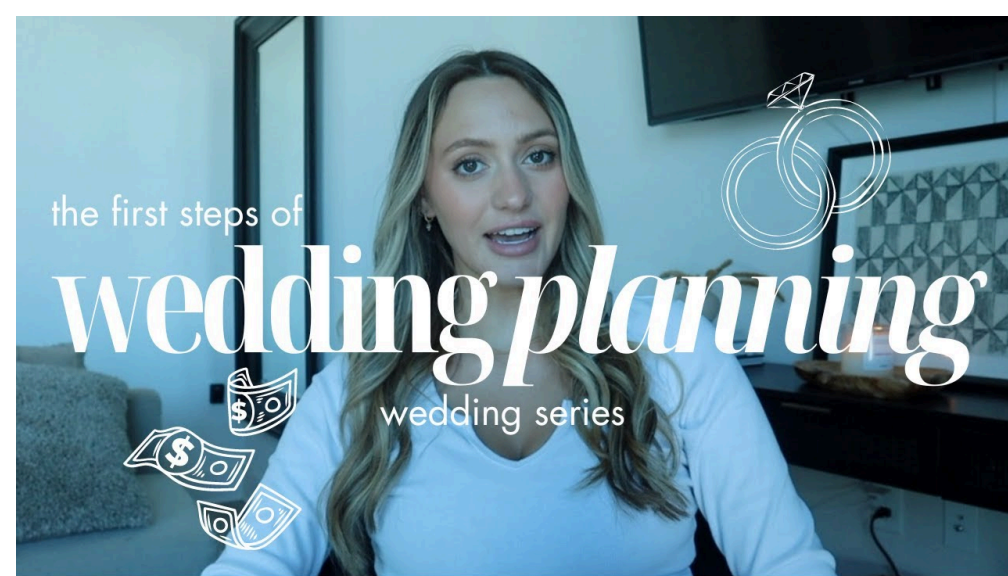
Get straight to it: "What's your pricing model?" Hourly rate. Then ask about hidden costs. Transport costs, excess hour rates, revision expenses. A transparent planner won't dodge these questions. Kollysphere agency is known for this level of clarity.

Signs to Stop Considering a Planner

Some issues are non-negotiable. When you spot these warning signs, remove that planner from your list.

"We don't really have space but maybe"—interpretation: they're overcommitted.

No clear numbers following multiple discussions—translation: transparency isn't their strength.



"All our weddings look similar because that's what works"—translation: they prioritise their portfolio over your dream.

Just verbal promises and nothing in writing—this signals: serious legal risk ahead.

The Final Grading System

After interviewing each candidate, give points per section from 1 to 5. Calculate the sum. The smart approach is: prioritise what matters most to you.

Imagine: When quick replies matter more than anything, multiply that rating. When costs are your main constraint, focus more on pricing than pretty pictures.

Resist simply adding and deciding. Have a conversation with your partner. The runner-up on paper just clicks better. That intuition counts.
