United Airlines Military Baggage Benefits

United Airlines offers enhanced baggage allowances to eligible active-duty U.S. military personnel and their dependents when traveling on official orders. The number of bags allowed and applicable weight limits can depend on whether the trip is official or personal travel.

For official military travel, eligible travelers may receive a higher baggage allowance than standard passengers. When traveling for personal reasons, military baggage benefits may still apply, although the permitted number and weight of bags can differ.

Because military travel rules can vary by itinerary, travelers should confirm the allowance associated with their specific reservation before arriving at the airport.

Baggage Allowance for Official Military Travel

Even when military baggage receives special consideration, certain restrictions may still apply. Some equipment may need to meet special packing or transportation requirements, while prohibited or restricted articles may not be accepted as regular checked baggage.

If you are traveling with unusual military equipment, contact United before your trip to determine whether the item can be transported and whether additional requirements apply.

Documents You Should Carry

To make the airport process easier, military travelers should keep important documentation readily available. Useful documents may include:

- Valid military identification
- Military travel orders, when applicable
- Flight confirmation or reservation details
- Documentation for eligible dependents
- Any required paperwork for special equipment

Having these documents available can help United representatives determine which baggage benefits apply to your journey.

Tips for Military Travelers

Pack efficiently and separate essential items from equipment that can be checked. Keep identification, orders, medications, valuables, and important travel documents in your carry-on bag.
