Maximum Size: **17 x 13 x 8 inches** (such as a purse, laptop bag, or small backpack)

IMPORTANT NOTES

- Carry-on bags must fit in the overhead bin.
- Personal items must fit under the seat in front of you.
- Additional or oversized bags may be subject to fees.
