



Can You Change a Delta Flight? Fees, Rules & Options

Travel plans can change unexpectedly because of work, family commitments, weather, or other circumstances. If you have booked a Delta flight and need to modify your itinerary, you may be wondering: Can you change a Delta flight? In most cases, yes. However, the available options, fees, and restrictions depend on your ticket type, route, and when you request the change.

Understanding the delta airlines change flight policy before making a modification can help you avoid unnecessary costs and choose the most suitable rebooking option.

What Is a Delta Flight Change?

Yes, eligible Delta tickets can generally be changed before departure. Delta allows travelers to modify details such as the travel date, departure time, or destination, subject to the fare rules that apply to their ticket.

For many flights originating in the United States or Canada, Delta Classic and Extra experiences do not have a traditional change fee. However, you may still have to pay a fare difference if the replacement flight costs more than your original ticket.

Delta Main Basic tickets have more restrictions and may require a change fee.



Delta Flight Change Fees

One of the most important parts of the **delta airlines change flight** process is understanding potential fees.

For eligible Delta Classic and Extra tickets originating in the U.S. and Canada, Delta currently states that there are no change fees. If the new flight has a higher fare, however, you must pay the difference in price.

Delta Basic fares are different. Changes or cancellations may involve a fee, and the exact amount can depend on the itinerary and fare rules. Therefore, passengers should review the price shown during the change process before confirming a new flight.

Delta Main Basic Restrictions

Delta Main Basic is designed as a lower-priced option with fewer travel-change benefits. After the 24-hour risk-free cancellation period, changes are generally not as flexible as Classic or Extra experiences.

Delta states that Delta Main Basic tickets may be changed or canceled for a fee before departure, depending on the applicable fare rules. Basic tickets also do not qualify for Same-Day Confirmed or Same-Day Standby travel changes.

This means travelers who expect their plans could change may want to consider a more flexible fare when booking.

24-Hour Risk-Free Cancellation

Passengers who book directly with Delta may have a 24-hour risk-free cancellation period. According to Delta, tickets purchased directly from Delta, including Delta Main Basic, can generally be canceled within 24 hours of booking for a full refund, provided the applicable conditions are met.

This can be useful if you notice an incorrect travel date, discover a better itinerary, or simply need to reconsider your booking shortly after purchasing it.

The 24-hour cancellation rule is different from making a normal flight change, so travelers should review the conditions before taking action.

How to Change Your Delta Flight Online?

Changing a flight through Delta's website can be relatively straightforward.

Steps for a delta airlines change flight request:

Visit Delta's website and open **My Trips**.

Select the reservation you want to modify.

Choose **“Change or Add Flights.”**

Review the available replacement flights.

Select your preferred itinerary.

Review any applicable fees or fare differences.

Confirm the change.

Save the updated confirmation.

Delta says passengers receive a new flight confirmation after completing the change process.

Changing a Flight Through the Fly Delta App

The Fly Delta app provides another convenient way to manage a reservation. Travelers can access their trip information, review available alternatives, and make eligible itinerary changes from their mobile device.

Using the app can be particularly helpful when plans change while traveling. Before confirming a new flight, carefully check the departure date, time, airport, connections, and total price.

If the desired option is unavailable online, contacting Delta directly may provide additional guidance based on the ticket and itinerary.

Same-Day Flight Change Options

Sometimes you do not need to change your entire itinerary—you may simply want to travel earlier or later on the same day.

Delta offers Same-Day Confirmed and Same-Day Standby options for eligible travelers. Same-Day Confirmed allows eligible passengers to switch to a confirmed seat on another flight when requirements and availability are met. Delta currently lists a \$75 fee for eligible Classic tickets, while certain Extra tickets and eligible Medallion members can receive the option at no charge.

Same-Day Standby may allow an eligible passenger to wait for an available seat on an earlier flight without paying a fee. Basic experiences are excluded from these same-day options.

Same-Day Flight Changes
