



How Does the Delta Airlines Change Flight Policy Work?

Travel plans can change because of work, family commitments, weather, or unexpected events. Delta Airlines provides several options for passengers who need to modify their itinerary. The rules depend on the ticket's Travel Experience, origin, destination, and whether the requested change is made before departure.

When using the delta airlines change flight option, travelers generally select a new flight through Delta's website or Fly Delta app and then review any applicable change fee and fare difference before confirming the new itinerary. Delta states that Classic, Extra, and Refundable tickets originating from the United States, Canada, or the Caribbean can generally be changed without a change fee, although a fare difference can still apply.

What Is the Delta Flight Change Policy?

Delta's flight-change policy allows eligible passengers to modify the date, time, and in some situations the routing of their journey. The amount paid for a change depends primarily on the ticket type and where the journey originates.

For many tickets, changing a flight means paying only the difference between the original fare and the new fare. However, some Basic tickets have additional change or cancellation fees. Delta recommends using **My Trips** on Delta.com or the Fly Delta app to review available options for an existing reservation.

Passengers should check the specific fare conditions attached to their ticket before making any modification because international and region-specific rules can differ.



Check Your Ticket Eligibility

Delta currently offers different Travel Experiences, and each has different flexibility.

Delta Main Basic

Changes are allowed for a fee in most cases. The ticket can also generally be canceled before departure for a cancellation charge, with remaining value issued as an eCredit. Basic tickets are not eligible for Same-Day Confirmed or Same-Day Standby changes.

Delta Main Classic

Flight changes are available, and for qualifying itineraries originating in the United States, Canada, or the Caribbean, there is no change fee. Same-Day Standby is available under the applicable rules.

Delta Main Extra

This option provides additional flexibility, including complimentary Same-Day Confirmed on eligible itineraries.

Are Delta Change Fees Still Charged?

Delta has eliminated change fees for many qualifying tickets, but **not every ticket is fee-free**.

For travel originating in the United States or Canada, Delta lists no change fee for Classic, Extra, and Refundable experiences. However, Basic fares can carry a change or cancellation fee. Delta's current published table lists a \$99 fee for Delta Main Basic on qualifying itineraries from the United States and Canada, while other Basic products can have different charges.

Travel originating outside the United States and Canada can have different fees. For example, Delta publishes separate fee schedules for travel originating in India, Europe, Africa, the Middle East, South America, Asia, and other regions. Therefore, travelers should verify their specific origin and ticket conditions before changing a booking.

Find Your Reservation

Passengers can use Delta's digital tools to complete many flight changes.

Basic Steps:

Visit **Delta.com** or open the Fly Delta app.

Select My Trips.

Enter the required trip details or access the reservation.

Select the option to change the flight.

Search for a new date, time, or available routing.

Review the fare difference and any applicable fees.

Confirm the change.

Check the updated confirmation sent by Delta.

Delta says customers will receive a new flight confirmation after completing the change process.

Fare Difference After Changing a Flight

A no-change-fee ticket does not necessarily mean that changing a flight is free.

When the replacement flight costs more than the original ticket, the passenger generally has to pay the difference in fare. For example, if the original ticket cost \$250 and the new flight costs \$325, the applicable fare difference would be \$75.

When the new flight costs less, Delta states that the difference may be issued as an eCredit, subject to applicable fees and fare conditions. This means the passenger should compare the total price of the new itinerary before confirming the modification.



Understanding Change Fees and Fare Differences

Delta Main Basic, formerly known as Basic Economy, has more restrictions than Classic or Extra fares.

According to Delta's current fare information, Delta Main Basic tickets are generally changeable for a fee in most cases. They may also be canceled before departure for a cancellation charge, with the remaining value provided as an eCredit.

Basic customers are not eligible for Same-Day Confirmed or Same-Day Standby changes. Delta also notes other restrictions, including limited seat-selection and upgrade benefits.

Because Basic ticket rules can vary by market and purchase date, travelers should review the conditions shown for their exact reservation.

Same-Day Flight Changes

Delta offers two important same-day options on eligible itineraries: Same-Day Confirmed and Same-Day Standby.

Same-Day Confirmed allows an eligible passenger to move to another flight on the same day when the applicable requirements and seat availability are met. Delta currently lists a \$75 fee for eligible Classic tickets, while the service is complimentary for Extra and certain qualifying refundable experiences and for Diamond, Platinum, and Gold Medallion members with Classic experiences. Same-Day Standby can allow eligible passengers to wait for a seat on an earlier flight without changing their confirmed seat until the standby request clears. Basic experiences are excluded from these same-day options.



Changing International Delta Flights

International delta airlines change flight rules can vary significantly depending on the origin and destination.

Delta publishes separate change and cancellation fee schedules for different regions. For example, flights originating in India, the Middle East, Africa, Europe, South America, and Asia can have fees that differ from flights originating in the United States or Canada.
