For example, a video with basic color, sound, and timing demands may take under 2 weeks to modify, depending upon the editors' routines.

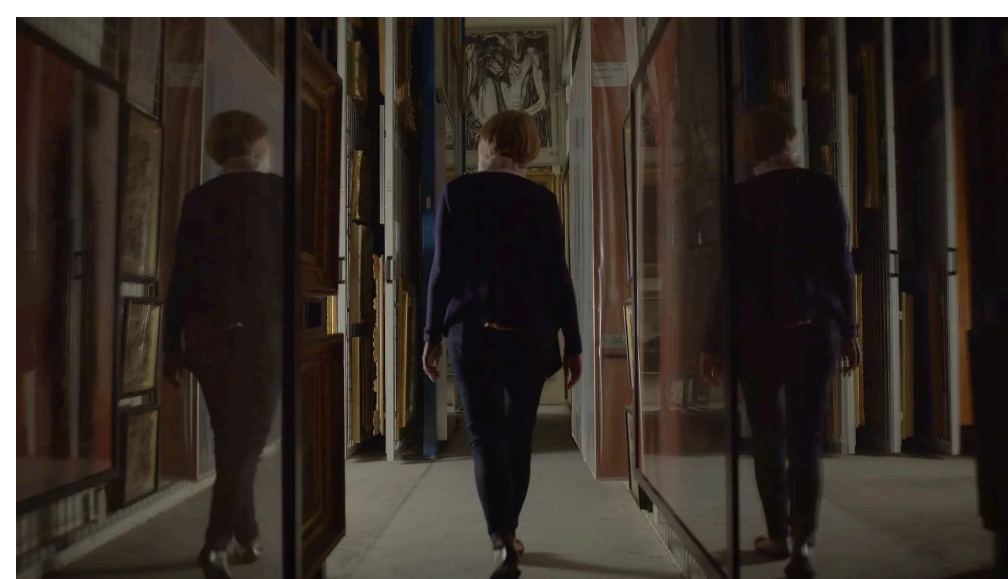
