- Road salt: From December with March, calcium chloride and salt experience know tires, then approach onto the bottom panel and equipment. Deterioration accelerates.

## **Winter: chilly binds, ice adhesives, steel shrinks**

On the chilliest early mornings, phones sound early. The pattern knows: the opener hums but the door will not move, or it rises a foot and reverses. Here's what the climate is doing behind the scenes.

Steel agreements in the cold. Tracks get simply a little bit tighter versus the rollers, and clearances close. At the exact same time, manufacturing facility oil on the rollers and joints enlarges. If you have nylon rollers, you're ahead of the game, however even they decrease in a January snap. The opener senses extra resistance and, depending upon settings, either powers with or stops to secure the system.

Bottom seals freeze to the piece. That rubber frost-weld is solid enough to stall an opener and strip a gear. If you see the lower astragal stuck, resist need to strike the switch consistently. Make use of a hair clothes dryer or pour cozy, not steaming, water along the seal to free it. After that towel off the threshold so it doesn't refreeze immediately.

Springs feel stiffer. Torsion springs provide torque by twisting steel cable. Cold minimizes flexibility, which means extra pressure is required to raise the same weight. If your springs were limited in October, they feel weak in February. You might notice the opener stressing, or the door drifting down when left midway open.

Photo eyes and tracks collect salt sludge. Roadway spray becomes a gritty paste that trips up on the rollers and integrates in the tracks. Paired with cool tightening, that grit suffices to halt a panel at mid-travel.
