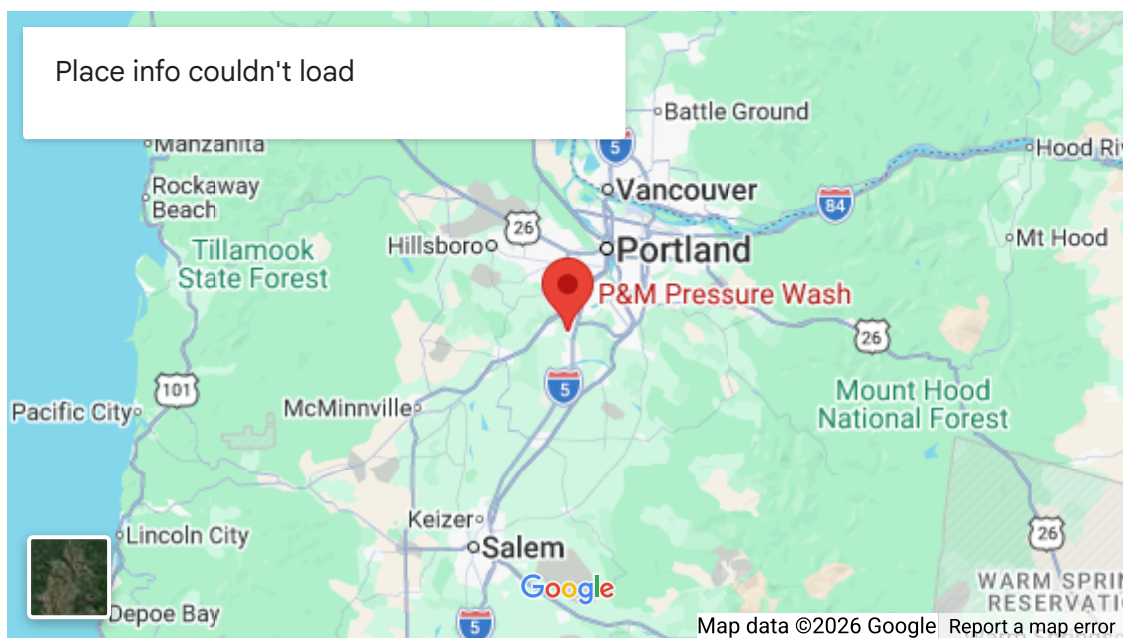

From the flooring, it looked like a easy dusting. Up near, the valleys held a two-inch layer of damp organics with white threads of fungus jogging by using it.

We staged tarps over hydrangeas and ran gutter socks. I tied off on the ridge and started dry. The blower cleared the high planes, however the valleys needed handwork. Four scoops later, the metal showed. I brushed granules that had pooled at a pipe boot, then lifted two fist-sized moss clumps that had grown over previous acorns. The gutters have been three-quarters full at the elbows. I loosened the plugs and enable a hose flush the rest into the sock.

When we sprayed the comfortable wash, the algae became from dark green to brown within fifteen mins. The moss darkened and slackened yet stayed on the floor, that is advantageous. I calmly rinsed the flashings and hardware, then left the sector to complete oxidizing. By late afternoon, the roof seemed uniformly clean. A week later, after a easy rain, the remaining moss husks had shed into the gutters in which the socks caught them. We emptied the socks and gave the gutters a closing payment. The home-owner felt like we had reversed 5 years in an afternoon, however the truly trick changed into an hour of affected person clearing formerly any chemical ever hit the roof.

When to call a pro
