What needs to be coordinated include accommodation, including room assignments, check in and check out processes, and handling of special requests (accessibility, dietary, medical). Breakout room and AV setup, ensuring each space has the equipment and supplies needed for its sessions, with backup plans for failures. contingency plans for weather (if outdoor activities are planned), illness (if a participant becomes unwell), technology failures (if AV or Wi Fi goes down), and schedule changes (if sessions run long or short).
