

Last Tuesday, we met a teacher in St. Lucie West with a 2017 Ford Escape. She had one flip key. We cut a second remote head key in 42 minutes, programmed with Smart Pro, and saved her \$131 versus her dealer's quote. Weather was muggy, 88 degrees, and her battery was borderline. We put a booster on it to keep programming steady. Little detail that avoids failures.

Two days later in Tradition, a contractor with a 2015 Chevy Silverado had a single worn key that stuck in the cylinder. We decoded the lock, cut a [Treasure Coast Locksmith near me](https://www.treasurecoastlocksmith.com) fresh HU100 blade on our laser machine, and paired a new remote. Total ticket \$239. He said, "Should've done this last year." He's right. Worn blades eat ignitions.

And in Palm City, a 2020 Toyota Camry push-to-start needed a second smart key before a road trip. We used an OEM fob, completed a 15-minute immobilizer registration, then tested lock, unlock, and remote start twice. Took 50 minutes door to door. No drama. Worth every penny.

## Dealer vs mobile locksmith for spare keys: what's better?

## Common mistakes we see in PSL that cost people money

Folks buy the cheapest Amazon fob, then call us when it won't program. Happens weekly. Some clones are fine. Many aren't. Honestly, I'd skip unknown-brand fobs for smart key vehicles. If you want to supply your own, we'll test it, but we can't warranty third-party parts. Another one, letting a battery die during programming. The immobilizer needs steady voltage. We always hook up a power supply. And [Treasure Coast Locksmith](#) using a worn key as the template. Bad idea. We decode your locks to factory spec when needed so your new key doesn't grind your ignition. Last one, waiting until you lose the only key right before a trip to Orlando. Stress you don't need.


## What affects spare key pricing on the Treasure Coast

Three things drive cost. Key type, security system, and parts availability. Push-to-start fobs cost more because they're not just a blade. They're a transceiver with rolling codes. Some makes like Toyota and Ford are straightforward. Nissan and Honda are usually fine. BMW, Mercedes, and late-model VW/Audi can need specialized equipment or dealer precoding. Also, chip shortages still pop up. If your exact fob is backordered, we'll offer a compatible alternative or quote OEM timing. We don't guess. We check your VIN against our databases and give you a real number before we schedule.

## Service areas and local details that matter for car keys

## **Our process, tools, and warranty**

We show up in a fully stocked van with cutters for both standard and high-security blades. Laser machine for HU66, HU100, and Toyota/Lexus high-security. Standard machine for classic edge-cut. We carry EEPROM and OBD programmers for immobilizer pairing, plus a regulated power supply so modules stay healthy. Every spare key job includes cutting, programming, and function testing. We test lock, unlock, trunk, panic, remote start if equipped, and we start the engine twice. You get a printed or texted receipt with the key or fob part number. - How much does a spare car key cost in Port St. Lucie? Most spares run \$129 to \$449 based on key type. A basic transponder key is \$129 to \$189, a remote key is \$169 to \$299, and a push-to-start smart key is \$229 to \$449. We confirm with your VIN and key photo before we book the job.
- Can you make a spare key if I only have one working key? Yes. We cut and program from your single working key on-site. It takes about 35 to 60 minutes for most vehicles. You'll avoid a tow and the higher "lost-all-keys" fees that kick in if the last key disappears.

## A few pro tips from the truck

- Change your fob battery every 18 to 24 months. Weak batteries cause intermittent starts on push-to-start cars.
- Don't swim with the smart key. Salt and electronics are a bad mix. Use a dry pouch at the beach or river.
- If your remote range drops, it's likely the battery, not the antenna. We can swap it while we cut your spare.
- Store the spare in a different spot than the primary. Sounds obvious. People toss both on the same hook. Bad day when they go missing together.

## **Frequently Asked Q&A's**

### **How much money does a locksmith charge?**

Locksmith services typically cost between \$150 and \$250 for common tasks like home lockouts, with a national average of roughly \$187–\$226. Basic car lockouts usually cost \$89–\$150, while replacing standard locks or rekeying ranges from \$50 to \$200+. Costs are higher for emergency, after-hours, or weekend services.

### **Is it cheaper to call a locksmith or replace a lock?**

You can change the locks yourself or hire a pro to replace or rekey the lock, which costs \$50 to \$100. Replacing a lock costs an average of \$315, as it requires a fair amount of both materials and labor. Professional locksmiths charge an average of \$75 per hour, and you won't need to replace the hardware.

### **How much does a locksmith charge for a replacement car key?**

Locksmith car key replacement typically costs between \$150 and \$250+, heavily dependent on key complexity and vehicle model. Simple metal keys cost \$95–\$100, while transponder keys are \$100–\$250, and modern smart key fobs range from \$200–\$600+. Locksmiths are generally cheaper than dealerships, which may also charge for towing.

## **Can I get a replacement key for my car without the original?**

You don't need the original key to replace your car key, but you may be asked to demonstrate ownership of your vehicle before an automotive locksmith or dealership will rekey the car.
