

A lock change in Orlando usually starts with a simple question, but it often leads to a bigger decision about security, wear, and day-to-day convenience. 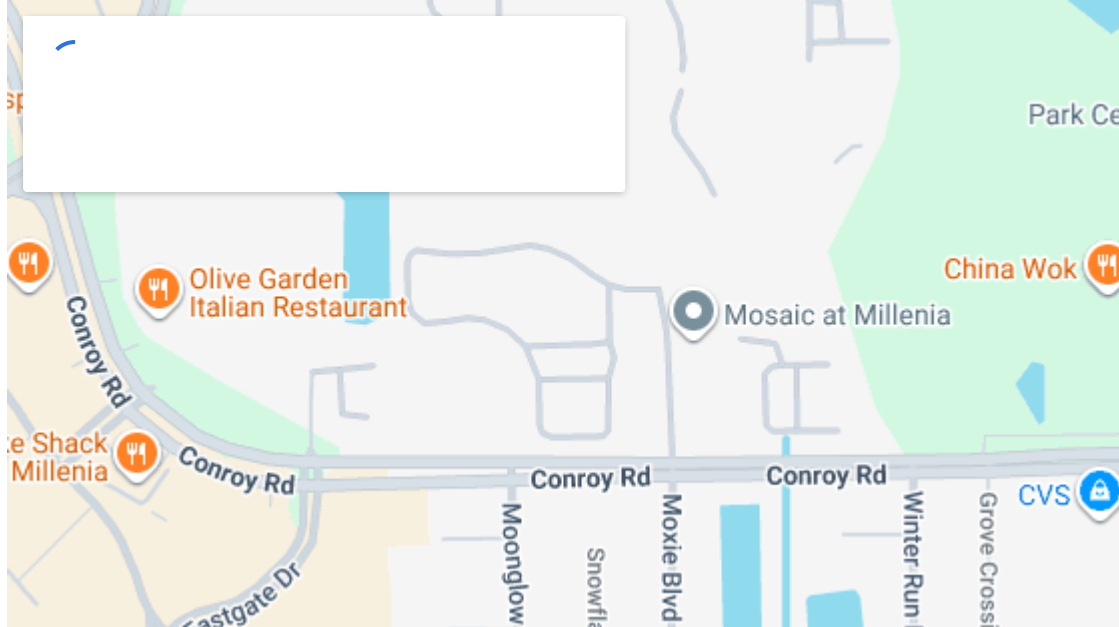
