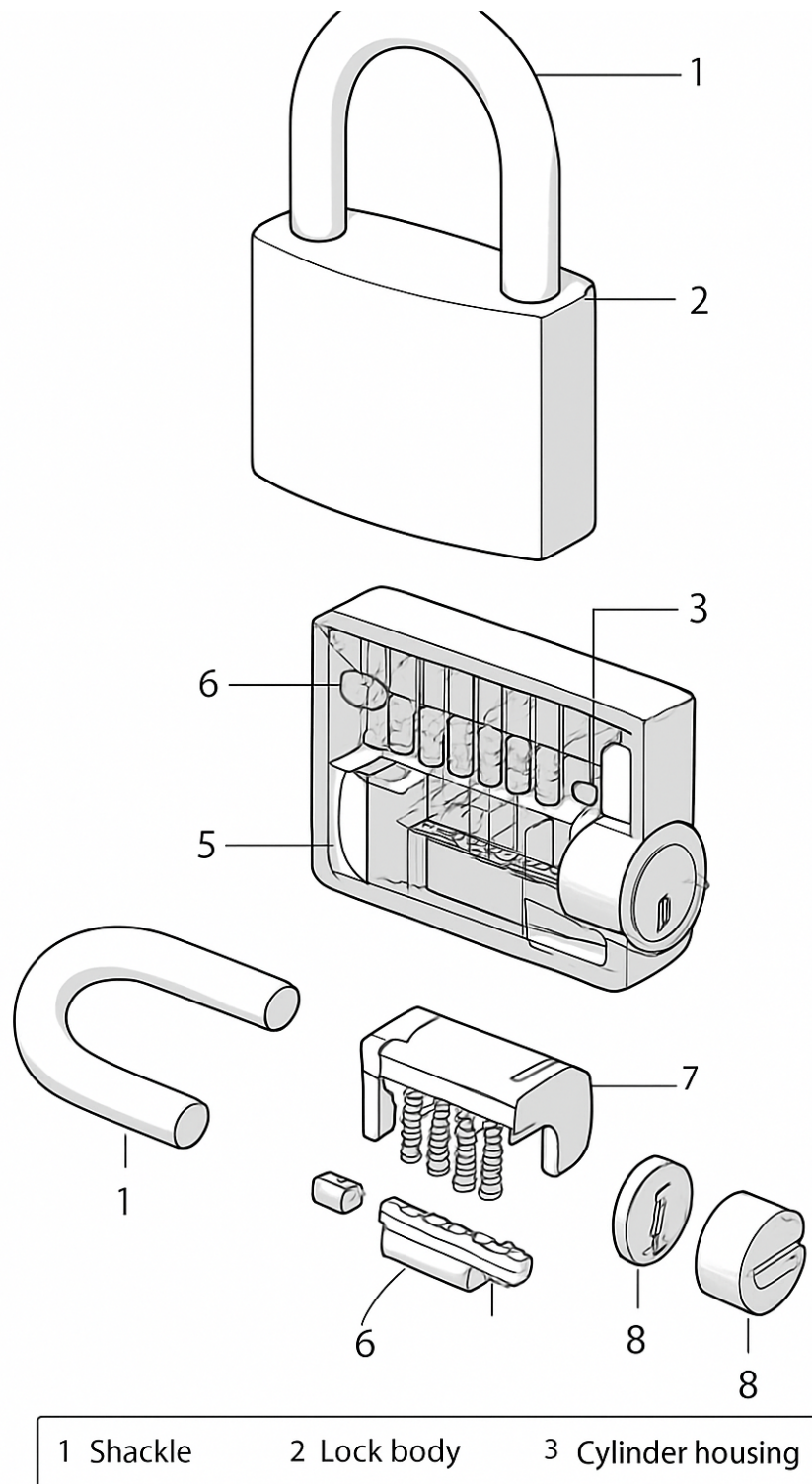

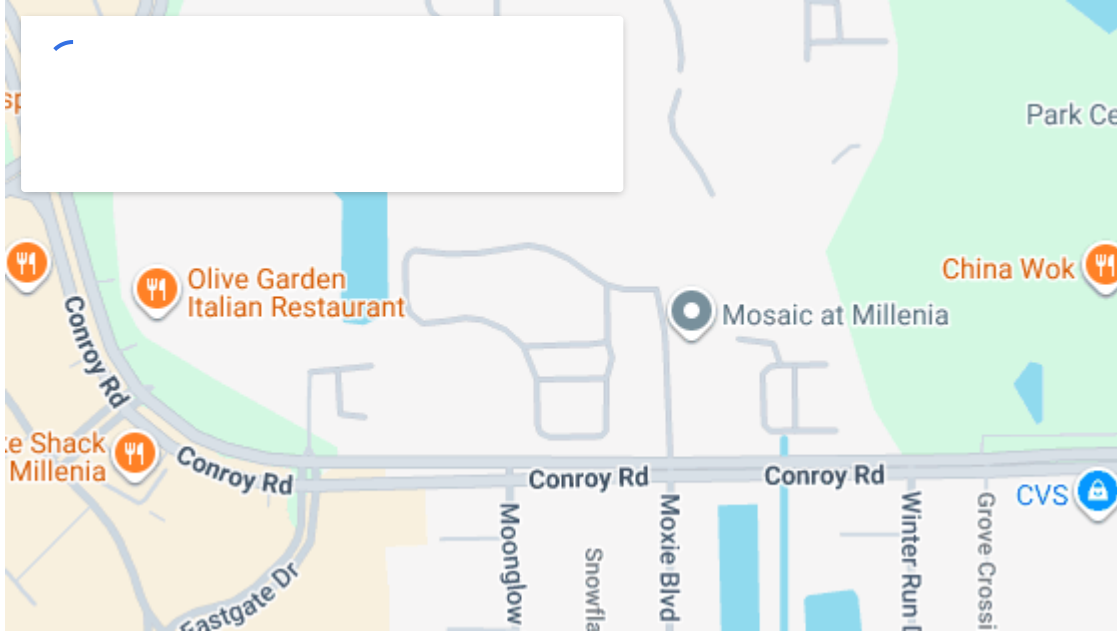
What licensing and trust mean in Florida
