When keypad and access control upgrades make sense

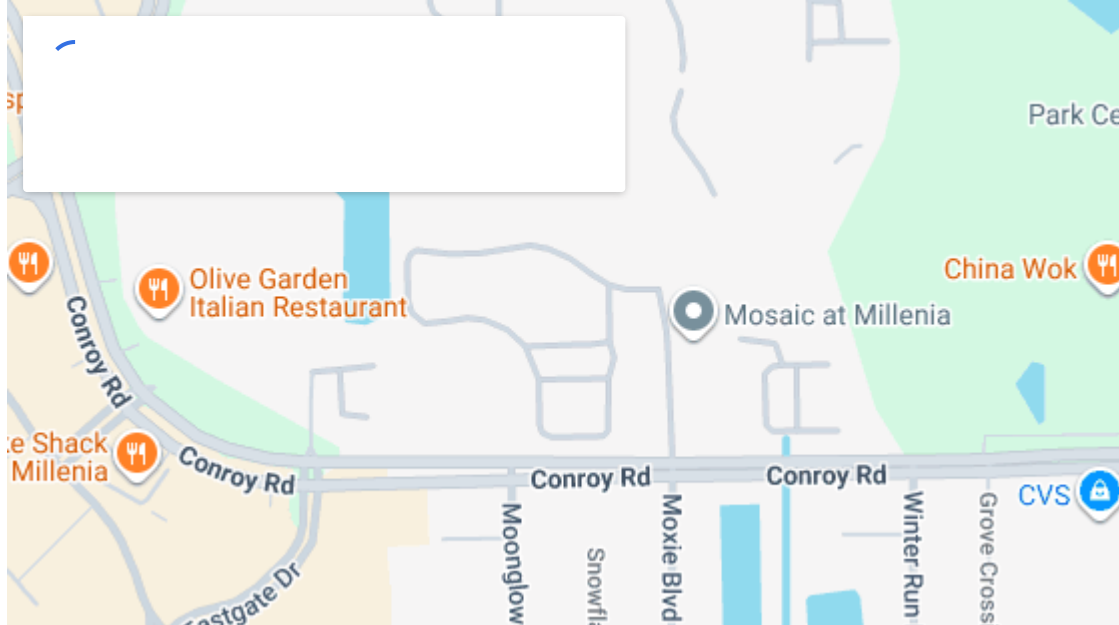
