

Low water pressure is one of the most frustrating plumbing problems for Murrieta homeowners because [Murrieta drain cleaning](#) it affects every water-using activity in the home simultaneously. Diagnosing the cause accurately determines whether the fix is simple or involves more significant work. The first step in diagnosing low pressure is determining whether the problem is isolated to one fixture, one area of the home, or affecting the whole house. A single low-pressure faucet usually indicates a clogged aerator from Murrieta's hard water mineral deposits. Unscrewing and cleaning or replacing the aerator resolves this in minutes. If multiple fixtures are affected or pressure is low throughout the home, the investigation needs to go deeper. The pressure regulator, typically located near the main water shutoff, controls the pressure delivered from the municipal supply into the home. A failed regulator can cause pressure that is too low or too high. Murrieta Valley Plumbing tests regulators and replaces them when they fail.

Partially closed shutoff valves are a simple cause that is often overlooked. If a shutoff valve near the water heater or main supply was partially closed during previous work and not fully reopened, it will restrict flow to all downstream fixtures. Scale buildup inside galvanized or old copper pipes is a progressive cause of low pressure in Murrieta's established neighborhoods. Decades of hard water mineral deposits narrow pipe interiors gradually. This type of pressure reduction requires either pipe cleaning or, in severe cases, [Plumber Murrieta](#) repiping to resolve. Slab leaks divert water from the supply system before it reaches fixtures, also manifesting as reduced pressure at fixtures throughout the home. Leak detection determines whether this is the cause.
