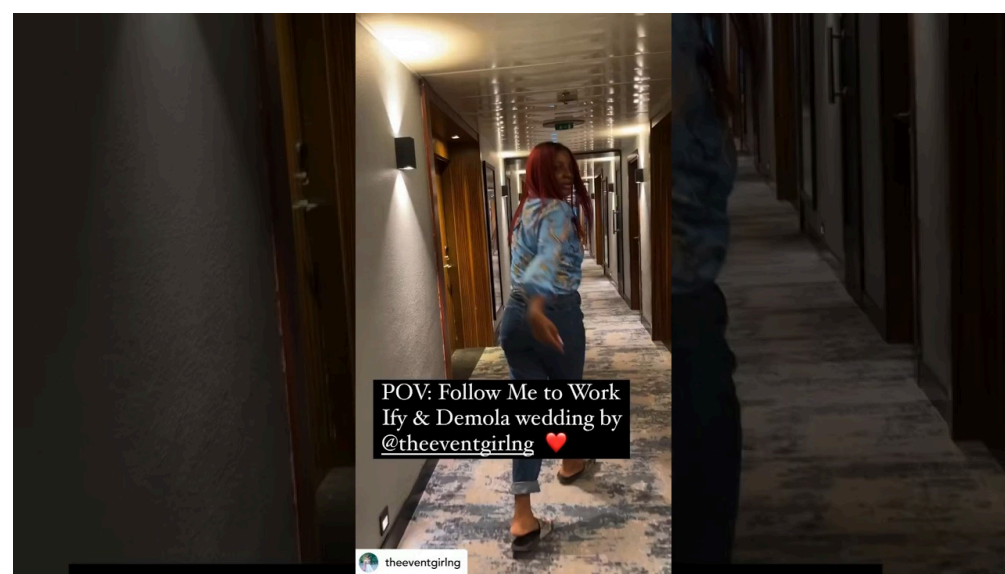

The Eyes and Hands You Can't Have

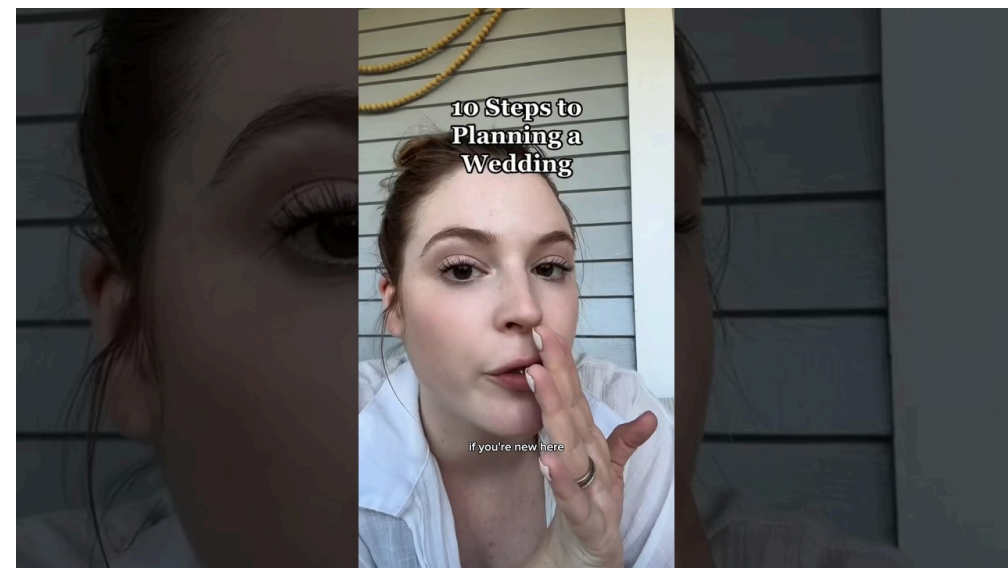
You have other things to do. You cannot direct vendors. Your wedding planner oversees every single detail of setup. They make sure the lighting is focused as designed. They catch mistakes.
