They happen after sunlight, rainfall, dirt motion, wind, and years of use.

Start with a site walk, not an item choice

It gets opened up and shut regularly, it takes knocks, and it's subjected to weather and dirt motion. A solid border fence can still be weakened by a gateway that doesn't straighten effectively or a latch that's easy to manipulate.
