# Carry-On Baggage Allowance

---

1

Passengers are generally allowed:

- One carry-on bag
- One personal item

2

Examples of personal items include:

- Laptop bag
- Handbag
- Backpack
- Small purse
- Briefcase

*The carry-on should fit safely in the overhead compartment, while the personal item must fit beneath the seat in front of you.*

*Always check your ticket type before traveling, as baggage rules may vary depending on your fare.*

# Carry-On Size Requirements

---

The standard **baggage allowance on Hawaiian Airlines** includes carry-on size restrictions.

**Typical maximum dimensions:**

Approximately 22 x 14  
x 9 inches

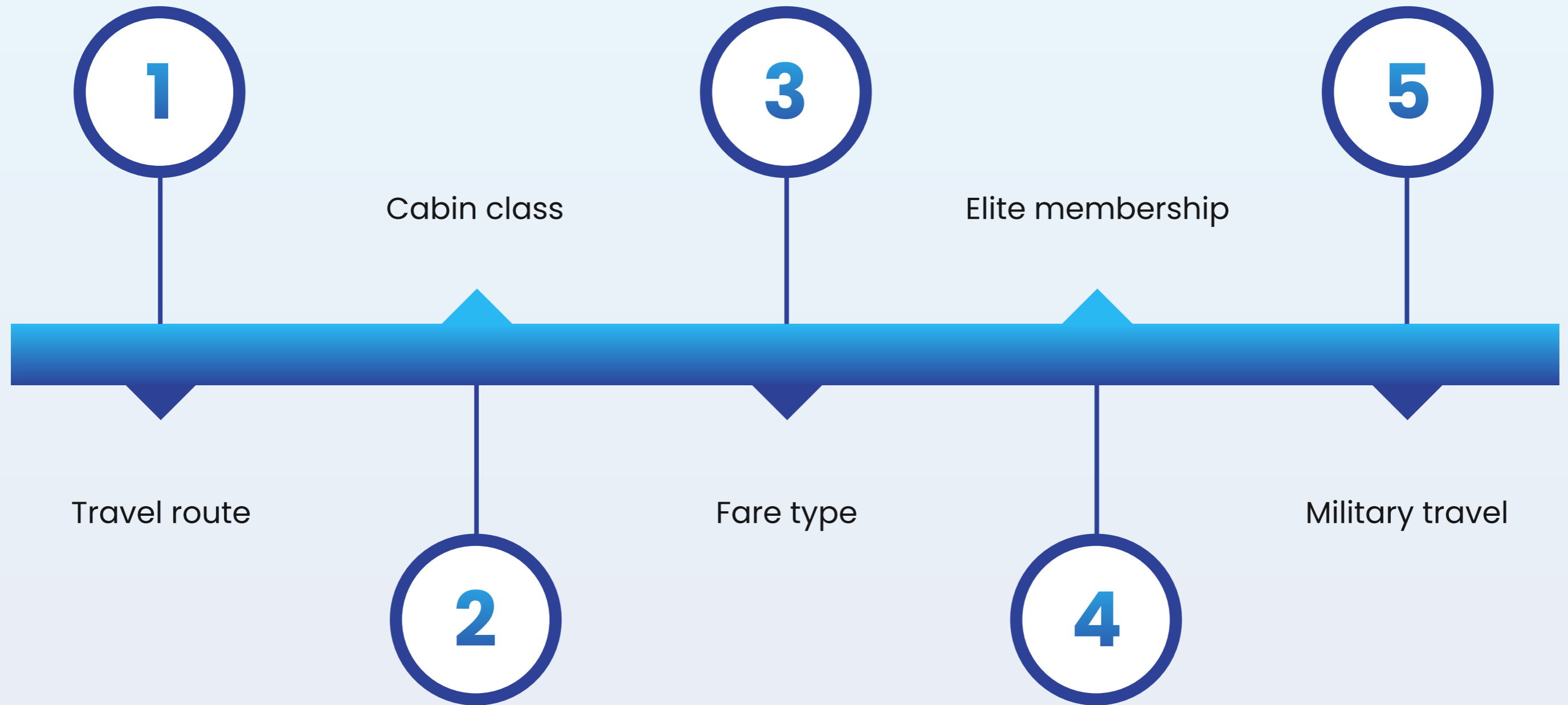
*Your carry-on should be light enough for you to place in the overhead bin without assistance.*

*If your bag exceeds the size limit, it may need to be checked at the gate.*

# Checked Baggage Allowance

---

Checked baggage policies depend on:



*Many travelers can check multiple bags, although fees usually apply unless included in the ticket or loyalty benefits.*

*Always verify your baggage allowance before departure.*

# Checked Bag Weight Limits

The standard **baggage allowance** on Hawaiian Airlines generally allows:

**Maximum weight:**

**1**

*50 lbs (23 kg) per checked bag*

*Bags exceeding these limits may incur overweight or oversized baggage charges.*

**Maximum linear dimensions:**

**2**

*62 inches (158 cm)*

*Packing efficiently helps reduce extra costs.*

# Checked Baggage Fees

---

1

Checked baggage fees vary depending on:

- Domestic flights
- Neighbor Island flights
- International routes
- Fare class
- Number of checked bags

2

Typical fee structure:

- First checked bag
- Second checked bag
- Third and additional bags

*Purchasing baggage online before arriving at the airport may help save time during check-in.*

# Oversized and Overweight Bags

Extra charges usually apply when baggage exceeds airline limits.

## Examples include:

- Bags over 50 lbs
- Bags larger than 62 linear inches
- Sports equipment
- Musical instruments
- Specialty luggage

Some oversized items may require advance approval.

*Always measure and weigh your luggage before traveling.*

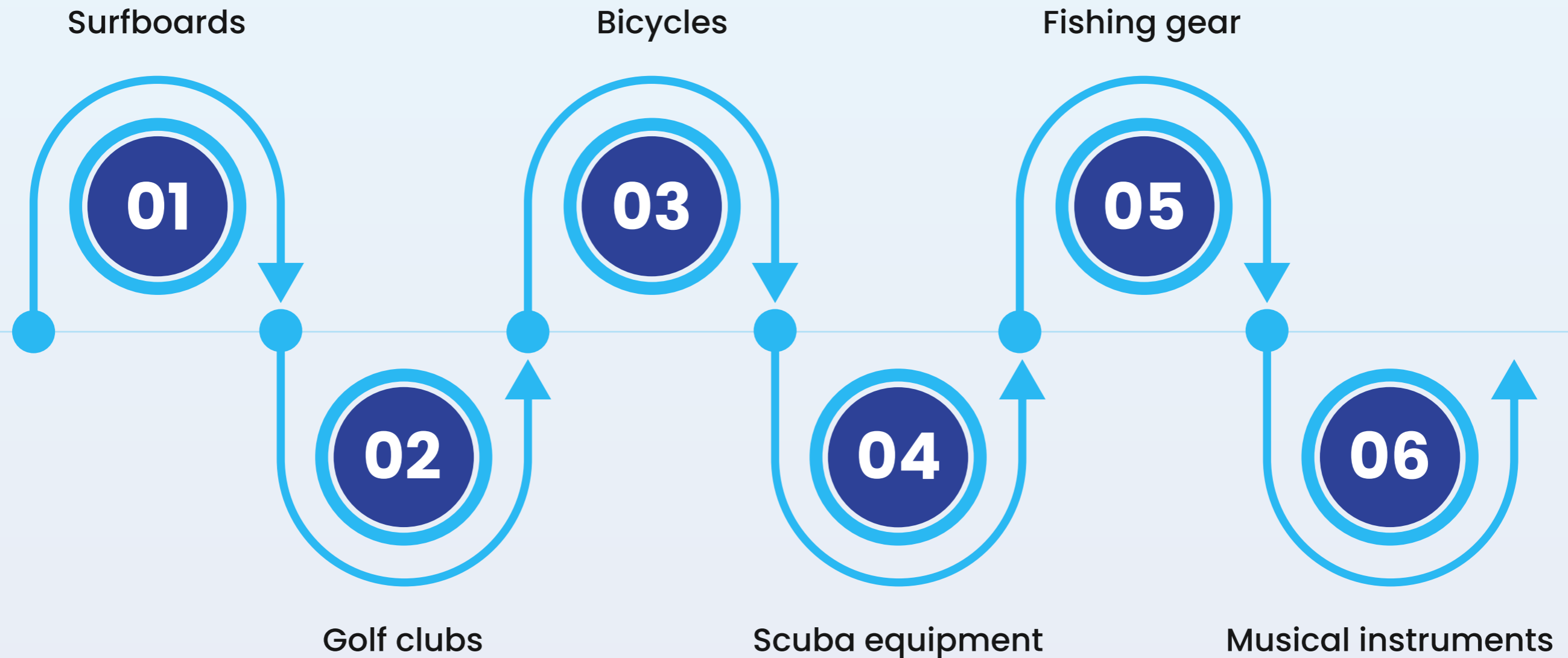


# Special Baggage

including:
